

Academic Council Resolutions 2020-2021

Scrutiny of the syllabus

- All the departments of Government Degree College for Women (A), Srikakulam through Board of Studies have resolved to implement Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in Autonomous Education system from academic year 2020-2021 for the newly enrolled students of batch 2020-2021.
- All the departments of Government Degree College for Women (A), Srikakulam approved and ratified the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th semester syllabus for batches admitted in 2020-2021 which was suggested by Andhra Pradesh State Council for Higher Education.
- All the departments of Government Degree College for Women (A), Srikakulam have approved and ratified the model papers submitted by concerned faculty members for all semesters and list of question paper setters.
- All the departments of Government Degree College for Women (A), Srikakulam have resolved to ratified to conduct 75 marks theory external examination and 25 marks internal assessment making it a total of 100 marks for each subject. 20 marks will be allotted through average marks obtained in two Mid-semester examinations and 5 marks will be allotted for assignments/seminars/viva-voce.
