

### Academic Council Resolutions 2022-2023

#### Scrutiny of the syllabus

- All the departments of Government College for Women (A), Srikakulam through Board of Studies have resolved to implement Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in Autonomous Education system for the academic year 2022-2023.
- All the departments of Government College for Women (A), Srikakulam have approved and introduced syllabus framed by APSCH for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. courses with 20 percent modifications.
