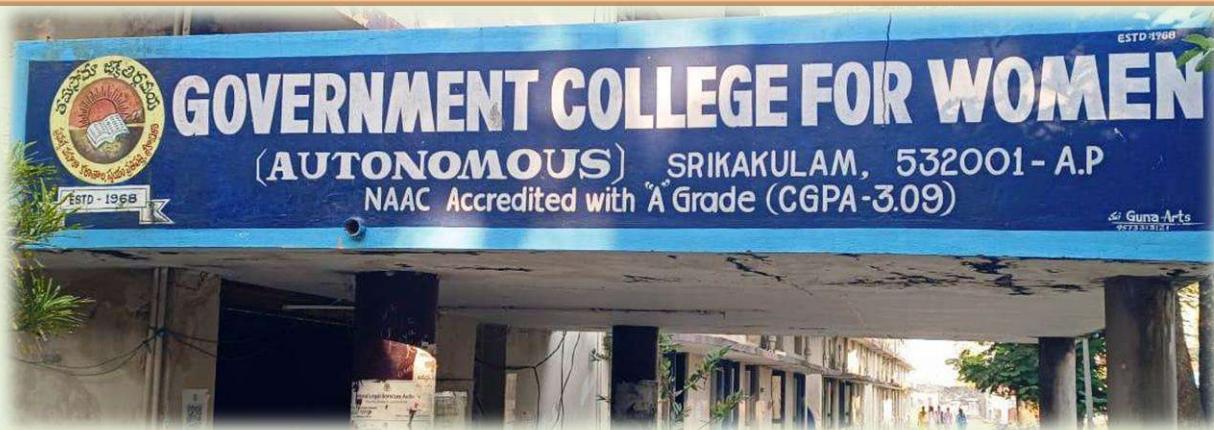

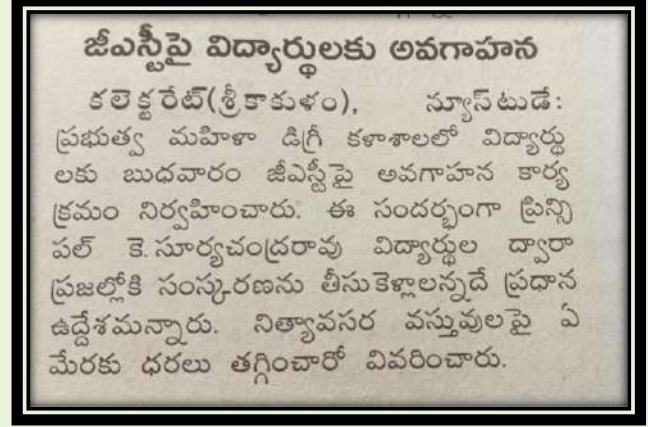

## ❖ Super GST Awareness Programmes



### Super GST Awareness Programs

Venue: Government College for Women (A), Srikakulam

As per the instructions of our Honourable Commissionerate, a presentation session on “Super GST” was organized by our college on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> October 2025. The session aimed to create awareness among students about the new taxation system and its implications. More than 150 intermediate students enthusiastically attended the session. Smt. Lalithabai, Faculty of Commerce, delivered an informative presentation on the topic. The students participated actively and interacted with the faculty with keen interest and attention.

Further, on 7th October 2025, as per the orders of the College Commissioner, an Essay Writing Competition on the topic “Super GST 2.0 – Super Savings” was conducted under the chairmanship of the College Principal, Dr. K. Surya chandra Rao. The event was organized by Dr. B. Prabhakar Rao, Faculty of Economics. About 50 students from Government Women's Junior College and Government Women's Degree College participated in this program and expressed their understanding and perspectives on the new GST reforms through their essays.

On this occasion, the Principal Dr. K. Surya chandra Rao addressed the students and highlighted the importance of Super GST in promoting transparency and efficiency in the tax system. He also urged the students to spread awareness about the initiative among rural communities to ensure wider public understanding. Both programs received an overwhelming response and succeeded in enhancing students' knowledge and civic awareness regarding the nation's evolving economic reforms.



### ❖ Awareness Seminar on GST
