VII. The Existing Non-detailed Text for II Semester General Telugu is 'Batukaata' written by V.S. Rasaani is having 20 marks weightage.


VIII. In place of 'Batukaata', a novel Swetchcha written by Olga is proposed to introduce as Non-detailed Text for General Telugu in II Semester.


IX. For I and III Semesters, the syllabus and Model Papers framed by the University holds good.

X. The syllabus for I, II and III Semesters of General Telugu including the Blue Prints of Question Papers are unanimously accepted to continue as appended to these minutes.


XI. The syllabus for Special Telugu for I to VI Semesters is continued as designed by the University.






