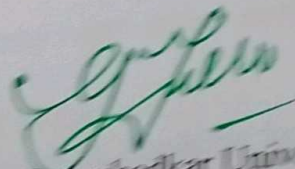
The 1st Board of Studies of the Department of COMMERCE met on 22-07-2019 at 10: 00 AM under the chairmanship of Dr.M.R Jyothi Frederick and resolved the following:

- 1) To implement the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in Autonomous Education system as per the Staff Councils proceedings commencing from the academic year 2019 – 2020 for the admitted 1 year degree students batch of 2019 – 2022 .
- 2) To approve and introduce the newly framed syllabus (modified and approved by the BOS) for the 1 year B.Com. Degree course in Commerce. The newly framed syllabus is oriented in such a fashion that it caters the needs of the student and to meet the present day job employability and to develop professionalism in the field of Commerce. .
- 3) To approve and ratify the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th semester syllabus of I&II year Core Commerce and Computer Application for the batch admitted in 2019 – 2020 and also approved and ratified the 5th and 6th semesters advanced & applied Core and Electives and cluster syllabi for the academic years 2019 – 20.
- 4) To ratify and introduce the Semester mode pattern of examinations for the 1st year students of B.Com.
- 5) Further it is approved and ratified the model question papers submitted by the concerned faculty members for all semesters. Out of 100 marks in each semester, 75 are for theory external examinations and 25 marks for internal assessment , 20 marks are provided for evaluation of conducting and taking average of two mid semester examinations and 5 marks are fixed for assignments/Viva-voce.
- 6) To conduct seminars, workshops, symposia, field visits and organizing exhibitions etc., to inculcate and create new ideology among the students.
- 7) To adopt NAAC norms by introducing quality circles among student community.
- 8) To develop infrastructural facilities in the department and implement guidelines of the Academic Council.
- 9) To take up innovative teaching (ICT mode of teaching) and evolve techniques that are easily understandable by the students and conduct remedial coaching to the below average students.

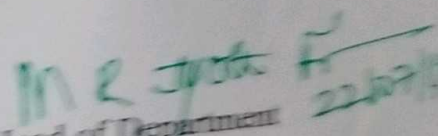
- 10) To encourage students to join IIC and APBIC to equip with communication skills and improve their personality development.
