Elocution Competition

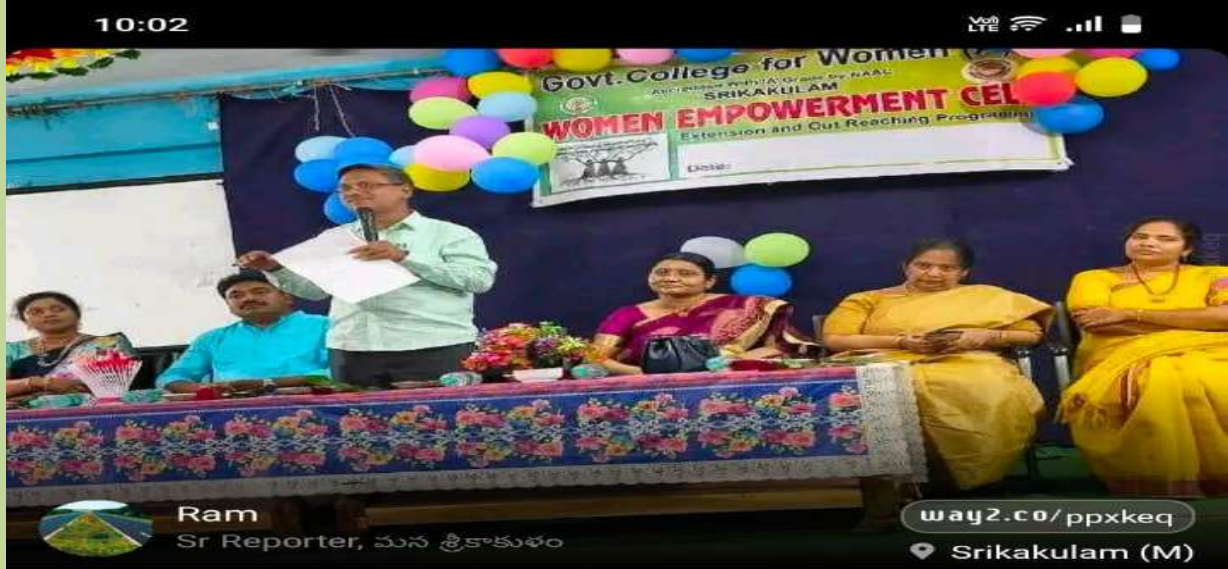

Thyroid Gland, Awareness campaign 10.03.2026

I Semester Results 18.03.2026

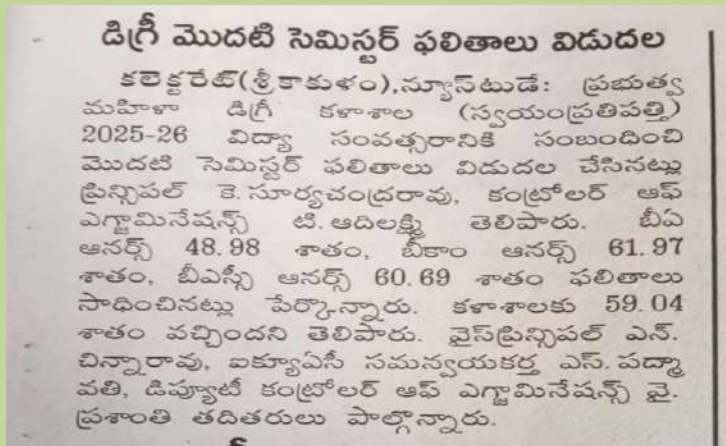
