
Consolidated report of Board of Studies for the year 2022-2023. The members of Board of Studies Held on 20/10/2022 at the Department of Mathematics under the chairmanship of Smt Y.Prasanthi, in-charge of Department Mathematics. The members discussed and resolved the following.

RESOLUTIONS


- 1) To implement the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in Autonomous Education System as per staff councils proceedings commencing from the academic year 2022,2023 for semester I,II,III,IV,V and VI of B.Sc students.
- 2) To approve/ratification and introduce the newly framed syllabus (modified and approved by the BOS) for semester I,II,III,IV,V and VI Courses in Mathematics. The newly framed syllabus is oriented in such a way that it caters to the needs of the students and helps them to meet the present day employability and to develop professionalism in the field of Mathematics.
- 3) To approve/ratification the I,II,III,IV,V and VI semesters syllabus of I &II year Mathematics for the batch admitted in 2020-2021.
- 4) To ratify and introduce the semester mode of examinations for students of all the years .
- 5) To approve and ratify life skill courses for 2nd year students (BA,B.COM,BSC).
- 6) Further, the model question papers submitted by concerned faculty for all the semesters were approved and ratified. It was decided that out of 100 marks in each semester, 75 marks are allotted for theory external examination and 25 marks for internal assessment. Regarding allotment of internal marks, 20 marks would be allotted by conducting two mid-semesters and the best score among the two mid-semester examinations will be considered and remaining 5 marks are fixed for academic and other performance.
- 7) To approved and ratify blue print and model question papers for 75 external marks for Mathematics.
- 8) To approve /ratify community survice project for first year students at the end of sem-2 w.e.f 2022-2023 as per NEP- 2020 .
- 9) To approve /ratify Internship –I , TWO Weeks training program for 2nd year students at the end of sem-4 w.e.f 2022-2023 as per NEP- 2020 .
- 10) To approve /ratify Internship –II, 6 months on job traing program for 3rd year students as 6th semester w.e.f 2022-2023 as per NEP- 2020 .
- 11) To approved and ratify blue print and model question papers for 50 external marks for Life skill course.
- 12) To conduct semesters, workshops etc., to inculcate and create new ideology among the students.
- 13) To adopt NAAC norms by introducing quality circles among student community.
- 14) To approve and list of Subject experts and paper setters of Mathematics.
- 15) To develop infrastructural facilities in the department and implement guidelines of the Academic Council.

- 16) To take up innovative teaching (ICT mode of teaching) and evolve techniques that are easily understood by the students and to conduct remedial coaching to the below average students.
- 17) To encourage students to join JKC to equip with communication skills and improve their personality development .
- 18) To encourage students to participate in the community development activities like NSS .
- 19) To approve and certify certificate courses.






